## FOR DAISIES

### Daisy Garden Party

We're excited to help you along your It's Your World- Change It! Journey for Daisies. In this 1.5 hour workshop, Daisies will explore our Conservation Corner and help to tend our garden, used to feed many of our animals. This active exploration will be tailored to fit well at any stage within the Garden Story. A special animal encounter, zoo admission, and parking is included.

## FOR BROWNIES

### Wonders of Water: Keeper Caper

Grab your magnifying glasses! During this thrilling "Keeper Caper," Brownies will explore the zoo as they collect clues to a mystery on a guided Twilight Tour. Girls will dive into their It's Your Planet - Love It: Wonders of Water Journey, by learning about the water cycle, uses of water (by us and our animals), and how we can all do our part to conserve it. An animal encounter, zoo admission, and parking are included.

Cost: \$35 per participant. 15 participant minimum, 30 maximum.

### Playground Scientists

Get ready to run, jump, stretch, and climb! Brownies will discover amazing animal adaptations through play, while on their It's Your Story – Tell it! Journey. Girls will explore the new Elinor Friend Playground, learning through movement how animals each have different talents in their habitat. Later, we will investigate and share similarities and differences between animals' talents and our own. An animal encounter, zoo admission, and parking are included.

## FOR ALL AGES

### Who's Who at the SF Zoo?!

Scouts will embark on a guided zoo tour and learn all about how animals come to live at a zoo, the difference between domestic and wild animals, the basics of exhibit design, and what goes into the care of our animal collection. In addition, girls will get an up-close encounter with one of our education animals. This tour is especially well-suited for troops with a mixture of Daisies, Brownies, and /or Junior Scouts. Parking and zoo admission included.

Cost: \$35 per participant. 15 participant minimum, 30 maximum.

## FOR JUNIORS AND OLDER

### Animal Behavior WildNight

Pack up your tents and explore the zoo on your It's Your Planet – Love It! journey on an exciting overnight adventure! Girl Scouts will spend the evening and morning hours (when the zoo is normally closed) investigating, observing, and discovering how animals use and conserve energy. We will also get a chance to see what it is like to be animal scientists, recording real data on animal behavior and then learning how professionals use that data to give high quality care to the animals. Don't miss this opportunity to have fun connecting to wildlife through an overnight exploration of energy, conservation, animals, and science! An animal encounter, zoo admission, and parking are included.

Cost: \$80 per participant. 30 participant minimum, 45 maximum.
